Quick facts

- · Most Asters bloom during summer and fall
- The provide a beautiful display of buds from August through October
- Unlike many other plants, Asters thrives as the days shorten
- Most Asters are long-lived perennials, lasting for many years in your garden





Upon Arrival

- Open all boxes and bags immediately upon receipt
- Check de condition of the plants in the boxes
- If you notice any damage, please contact your sales rep within 7 days



Pot size

• Recommended pot size: Ø 17-19 cm; 1 bare root per pot



Planting

- · Best time for planting is early spring
- · Aster prefers priority planting
- Check the roots before planting and discard any soft roots
- Best temperature for starting cultivation is between 35-55F / 2-12°C
- Plant bare roots in a well-draining soil
- Firm the soil around the roots to prevent air pockets
- · The eyes of the bare roots has to be planted just below soil level, no more than one inch deep



Watering

- · After the initial watering, wait until the plants emerge before watering again
- · Keep the soil consistently moist but not waterlogged
- Water Asters during dry periods
- Once established, Asters can tolerate short droughts but perform best with consistent moisture



Ongoing care

- Once established, Aster require minimal attention
- Begin fertilizing after the root system is well-developed
- · Use a balanced, all-purpose garden fertilizer in the spring to provide necessary nutrients for the growing season
- Cut back the plants to the ground In late autumn



Prevention and protection

- · Monitor for aphids, powdery mildew, and rust
- Ensure good airflow and avoid overhead watering to reduce the risk of disease
- · Watch for brown specks on petals; this could indicate Botrytis blight
- · Avoid sprinkler irrigation and enhance air circulation around the plants
